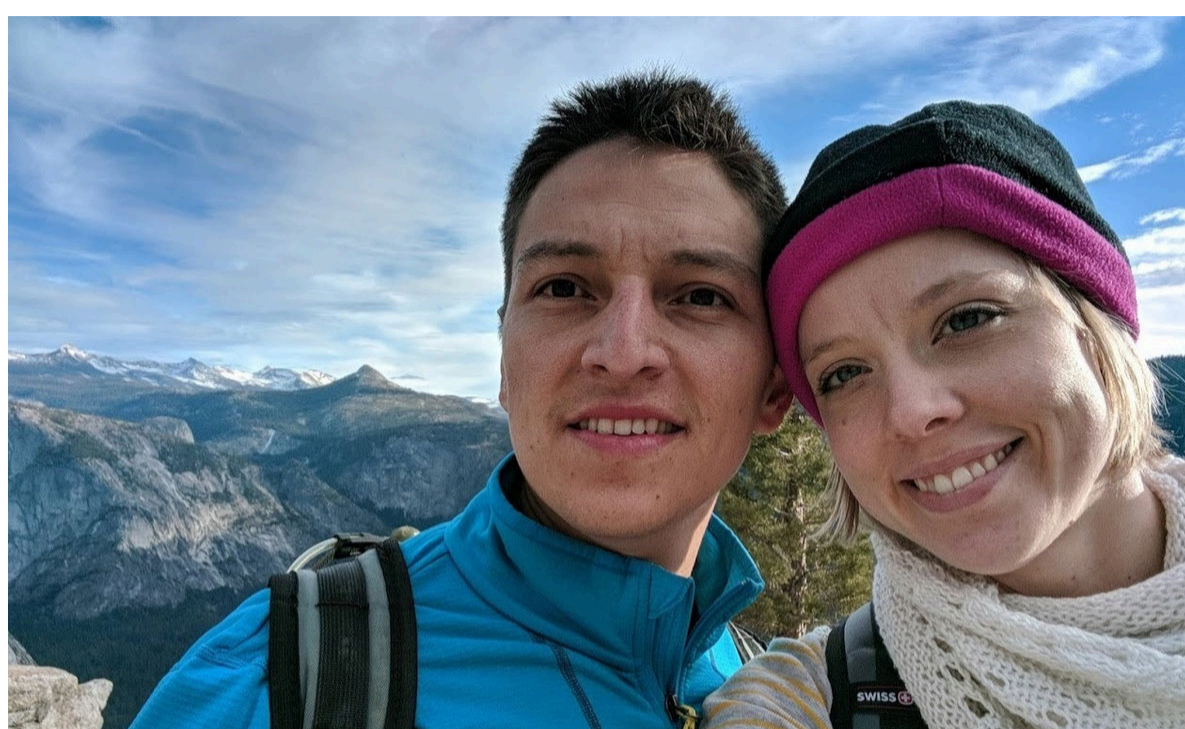


Happy New Year to All!
